CATEGORIES

The competition will be judged in the following three (3) categories:

- Forms 1 2
- Forms 3 4
- Forms 5 6

PRIZES

- Nine (9) finalists will be selected (1st, 2nd & 3rd in each of the above stated categories).
- The winning artworks would be displayed publicly at a location to be announced.
- A prize for the school that submits the MOST entries.
- And MUCH more!

GUIDELINES/RULES

- All secondary school students of Trinidad and Tobago are eligible.
- Schools are allowed to submit multiple entries.
- One entry per student to be submitted with a completed entry form.
- Parental permission must be granted for students 17 years and under.
- The artwork can be in the form of a drawing, painting, collage or mixed media on a base measuring (18" x 24") unmounted and related to the theme "Tourism and Wellness".
- All entries must be accompanied by a brief written description (not more than 250 words) of the artwork submitted, explaining how it relates to Tourism and Wellness.
- Artwork should be an ORIGINAL CREATION of the entrant.
- The Ministry of Tourism, Culture and the Arts maintains the right to reject any artwork that differs from the corresponding entry information.
- The judges' decision is FINAL.
- All submitted artwork will remain at the Ministry for the entirety of the competition.
- Children of employees of The Ministry of Tourism, Culture and the Arts and its agencies are NOT eligible to enter.
- All unsuccessful entries MUST to be collected during the period December 12-16, 2022 from 9:00 a.m. 3:00 p.m. The Ministry will **NOT** be responsible for any artwork left uncollected beyond the aforementioned period.

N.B. According to the Global Wellness Institute "Wellness" refers to the active pursuit of activities, choices, and lifestyles that lead to a state of holistic health. Additionally, wellness tourism is defined as travel associated with the pursuit of maintaining or enhancing one's personal wellbeing. As such wellness will include, but is not limited to, activities that aid in maintaining a healthy lifestyle, reducing stress, preventing disease, and enhancing one's wellbeing through physical, physiological or spiritual activities.

Release or waiver – The Ministry reserves the sole and absolute right to use the participant's name, photograph and artwork as well as to publish and reproduce same on the Ministry's website, social media and/or any other platform the Ministry, in its sole discretion decides, for promotional purposes.
